Special Meeting of the Board of Directors Friday, January 15, 2021

The Board of Directors (the "Board") of the East End Improvement Corporation ("EEIC"), met in a special session, open to the public, via video/audio conference on **Friday, January 15, 2021, at 12:00 p.m.** The video/audio conference meeting was authorized pursuant to the March 16, 2020 Declaration by the Governor of the State of Texas, which suspended certain provisions of Chapter 551, Texas Government Code, in response to the Coronavirus (COVID-19) disaster. The Governor's Proclamation permitted governmental bodies to conduct meetings via telephone or videoconference to advance the public health goal of limiting face-to-face meetings (also called "social distancing") to slow the spread of the COVID-19.
