

## Rail Corridor Collaborative – UPRR Update

- Leadership is aligned is ensuring railroad operations are efficient and blocked crossing reduction is a priority
- Operational Adjustments are ensuring train routing is efficient
- Making infrastructure investments to reduce bottlenecks and stoppages
- Increasing visibility of blocked crossing events:
  - Track Tags
  - Email Notifications
  - Dispatch Alerts
  - Use of Cameras and other Sensors
- Consistent Communication with other railroads, Houston First Responders,
  FRA and community leaders
